



ENTRY LEVEL READINESS ASSESSMENT

SYLLABUS

GRADE - II

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The assessment will focus on oral communication and writing skills.
2. Each child will participate in a one-on-one interaction with the teacher in a friendly and supportive environment.
3. The assessment will be based on the child's identification skills, observation ability, vocabulary usage, and overall confidence.
4. A set of common objects/items will be provided for identification, followed by oral questions related to them.
5. An inability to respond or providing incorrect answers does not necessarily disqualify a child from selection.

The assessment will be conducted based on the following topics.

Conversational Skills (Orals):

- **About Self:** (self-introduction in 6-7 lines)
- Good habits and use of magical words (please, sorry, thank you)
- Days of the week and Months in a year
- **Rhymes:** English and Hindi (one each)

Writing Skills:

Literacy:

- Use of a / an , this/ that, these/those
- Naming words
- One and many (s/es)
- Preposition words (in, on, under)
- Adjective (Describing words: - E.g.: - black, fat, one etc.)
- Opposite (fat/thin, hot/ cold, day/night, black/white, big/small, near/far, high/ low etc.)
- Unseen passage (Reading Comprehension) with fill in the blanks

Numeracy:

- **Concepts:** before, after, between, and missing numbers, greater than and smaller than (>, <, =) (1- 100), ascending & descending order (1-200),
- **Counting:** sequence counting (1 – 500), backward counting (50 – 1), skip counting of 2, 3 and 5
- **Number names:** one – hundred
- **Shapes-** 2d and 3d shapes (circle, oval, square, triangle, rectangle, cube, cylinder etc)
- **Addition & Subtraction** of 2 digits numbers
- **Tables:** 1-10 with dodging

Hindi:
